NOTES FROM THE ANNUAL CONGREGATIONAL MEETING, JANUARY 28...

Despite the heavy, wet snow that quickly blanketed Bristol on Sunday morning, 38 voting members participated in the Annual Congregational Meeting after worship on Sunday morning. Reports from congregational leaders and committees were heard. Gratitude was expressed for the many healthy ministries of the congregation and for the faithful folks who contribute to their work. The continuing work of the Four Church Collaboration Committee with representatives from St. Andrew, Zion, Grace and Gloria Dei Lutheran Churches was a focus of much conversation. The Committee continues to make progress toward its goal of building a strong partnership among the four churches that will lead to the formation of a new congregation.



A 2024 Ministry Budget totaling \$167,075.00 was approved. Bob Herold (President), Britt Lynch (Vice-President), and Abigail Griffin were re-elected to serve on the Congregation Council. Connor Pratt was elected to a three year as youth representative to the Council. Arlene Creswell, Britt Lynch and Connor Pratt were elected to serve as our representatives to the New England Synod Assembly in June.

LOOKING AHEAD TO LENT...

It seems early, but yet the season of Lent, the time of returning to and renewal in the very roots of our faith lives, begins on **Ash Wednesday, February 14**. This year we will be joining with our partner Lutheran congregations to mark the significant days of Lent and Holy Week.

There will be two Ash Wednesday services, at Zion Lutheran Church at noon (with a lunch to follow) and at Grace Lutheran Church in Plainville at 7:00 p.m.

During Holy Week, Maundy Thursday (March 28) worship will be at Gloria Dei Church, and Good Friday worship (March 29) will be hosted by St. Andrew.

And yes, Easter Sunday is early, very early! March 31.
