FOUR CHURCH COLLABORATION MEETING, 1:00 P.M., AT ST. ANDREW TO HEAR PROPOSAL FOR NEW MINISTRY

Please plan on attending this very important Four Church Collaboration meeting this Sunday, March 10, Sunday, 1:00 p.m., at St. Andrew Church, when the Collaboration Committee will present its proposal for moving ahead in forming a new community of faith from our four Lutheran congregations in Bristol and Plainville.

The Proposal will include a vision for how the new ministry might unfold in the coming months as well the Committee's carefully considered proposal for where the new ministry will be located.

Each of our four congregations will take this Proposal back for congregational consideration and conversation over the coming weeks. No votes regarding the proposal will be taken this Sunday. On April 7 each congregation participating in this collaboration process will be holding formally called Congregational Meetings for the purpose of acting on the proposal and deciding to move ahead in the process of the four congregations forming a new ministry.

Because we are expecting a large turnout for this important meeting, it will be held in the nave of the church.

The Rev. Steven Wilco, Associate to the Bishop of the New England Synod, will facilitate the meeting. He has been working with the Collaboration Committee since last summer.

The Proposal will be forwarded via email or land mail to all our members next week after its distribution at the meeting.

At St. Andrew we will be having an informal congregational meeting during the coffee hour after worship on Sunday, March 17, in order for people to further discuss the proposal and its implications. This will be to help us prepare for the formal Congregational Meeting on April 7 when we will vote on the proposal.

Please stay informed as we move closer to making very important decisions about ministry in the weeks ahead. Ask questions. And keep our four congregations in your prayers that we may all listen to the Spirit's guiding us into a new day.

Our thanks to Arlene Crenshaw, Karen Biernat, Owen VanBrocklin, and Bob Herold who have faithfully served on the Four Church Collaboration Committee along with representatives from Zion, Grace and Gloria Dei Churches.
