Grace, Plainville, Zion, Gloria Dei and St. Andrew, Bristol.

The Proposal has been distributed to the congregation in previous mailings. It is also available currently
in the church office.

If the vote on the Proposal is positive, we will then vote to appoint three members of this congregation
to serve on the new Transition Steering Committee that will guide the process toward consolidation and
serve as the Congregation Council

for the first 12 months of the new congregation's existence. We will also appoint two people to serve
on the Call Committee which will be responsible for the process leading to the call of a new pastor to
serve the new congregation. Each of the four congregations will have equal representation on these
important Committees. Nominated by our Congregation Council to serve on these Committees are:

Bob Herold, Karen Biernat and Bill Golden for the Steering Committee, and Britt Lynch and Arlene
Creswell for the Nominating Committee.
